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Course Description:

Logic is the art of reasoning well – of learning to think God’s thoughts after him. This course will introduce students to logical thought, the basic terms and definitions used in logic, syllogisms, arguments and informal fallacies.

This course will be a video taught course. Students will meet once per week to watch videos, discuss and begin homework. The facilitator for this course will be available to assist students during class. They will also administer and grade quizzes and exams. .

Purpose :

- Control the debate by defining your terms
- Think logically when you can write true and false statements
- Disprove invalid arguments when you know the rules
- Detect when someone else is arguing badly.
